

# Beginning Freshman Honors Scholarship

- The Beginning Freshman Honors Scholarship is awarded to a student entering Southeastern as a beginning freshman.
- Any beginning freshman student admitted with a 23 or higher ACT composite and a minimum 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) qualifies for a scholarship at Southeastern.
- Housing supplement only available to students living on campus.
- All scholarships are awarded for eight semesters.
- The application for admission serves as the application for scholarships.

Below is the scholarship grid that indicates the annual scholarship award students may be qualified to receive. Eligibility is based on full-time status.
